Course objectives	Familiarization with the conceptual-categorical and methodological structure of New Testament Exegesis, mastery of New Testament interpretation through competent independent synchronous/diachronous work on (selected) texts, thus preparing the student for effective application of the New Testament message.			
Learning outcomes	Understanding of the historical development of the basic concepts of New Testament exegesis, mastery of the principles of patristic and historical-critical exegesis, as well as enabling students to undertake independent exegetical synthesis in order to effectually actualize the New Testament text.

Lectures	1. Introduction to New Testament exegesis: theological argumentation; 2. The historical development of New Testament exegesis with a particular emphasis on the influence of the Serbian exegetical tradition; 3. Exegetical analysis of selected sections of historical texts of New Testament literature: Mark 1:21-28, Matthew 1-2; 3:17; 5:1-10; 6:9-13; 12:22-32; 17:1-9; 26:17-36,66; Luke 15:11-32; 18:9-14; John 1:1-18; 2:1-11; 5:1-18; 20-21; Acts 2; 4. Exegetical analysis of selected sections of the New Testament epistles: 1 Cor. 13:1-13; Eph. 5:23-33; Rev. 1-21.			
Practical classes (exercises, additional forms of classes, research work)	The above thematic units are addressed in their applied forms, with an insistence on analysis and interpretation of selected New Testament texts, as well as the active and productive usage of literature by means of doing translation from foreign languages, by the presentation of exegetical themes and problems within the context of the exercises and independent seminar work.
