Practical classes (exercises, additional forms of classes, research work)	Applying the same thematic units in their applied forms, with an insistence on the skill of recognizing theological concepts within the New Testament canon, along with enabling active and productive usage of literature in translating from foreign languages, presenting theological themes and problems within the New Testament in the context of exercises or independent seminar work.
