Lectures	1. Liturgics as a fundamentally theological discipline. 2. Theoretical and practical introduction to basic, general knowledge about historical assumptions about the emergence of Christian worship and its subsequent development through different historical eras. 3. Theoretical and practical introduction to the Christian temple structure, liturgical vessels and vestments, liturgical books, along with the common characteristics of individual divine services. 4. Sources of Christian divine worship. 5. Sources of liturgy.			
Practical classes (exercises, additional forms of classes, research work)	The same thematic units in their applied forms (with an insistence upon qualified analysis of relevant sources, synchronous, diachronous, and confrontative observation and generalization of liturgical concepts and elements, along with an active and productive usage of liturgical, teleturgical, and theological literature. Introduction to different perspectives and elements of Christian divine services by means of active participation in the divine services. Independent research of individual topics related to the divine services. Due to the specific nature of the Faculty, the teaching system includes, on the basis of the Statute, two different educational structures are present: pastoral-catechetical and practical-liturgical praxis.
