Theology of the sacred canons concerning the entry into the Church; layman's baptism, clinics, baptism in heretical communities, baptism in home churches 3. Theology of sacred canons concerning the life of the Church; monk's typica and the position of the monasteries and the monks; lay ministry in the Church. 4. Theology of the sacred canons relating to the entry into the clergy and lifestyle of clerics.
