<b>Course objectives</b>	Acquiring of ability for understanding of professional texts and usage of professional literature in German language, developing of communication skills and giving thorough explanation regarding an attitude, problem or idea. Written expression is developed alongside with oral, in the form of short coherent texts, written as homework or a resume.			
<b>Learning outcomes</b>	With the gradual mastering of the material, through colloquia, A2 level of common European framework of reference for languages is expected to be achieved.

<b>Lectures</b>	The course implies already achieved level of B1 of common European framework of reference for languages. The course implies usage of authentic texts in narrow field of studies, various in style, register and level of difficulty. Since the knowledge of the basic grammar categories is taken for granted in this course, the main stress is put on learning and exercising of professional vocabulary, expressions and constructions. Thematic content of the course is in the service of course objectives and based on the texts in narrow field of studies.
