Course content			
Lectures	1. The origin and occurrence of Christian liturgy; development of liturgy by chronological stages. 2. Theoretical and practical study of divine worship of Byzantine liturgical form. 3. Theoretical and practical introduction to comparative liturgical forms. 4. Elaboration of theological attitudes on the meaning of liturgy from the aspect of man-God and God-creation relations. 5. Presentation of theological attitudes on liturgy within the framework of the problems of liturgical time and liturgical space. 6. Pointing to theological meaning of individual parts of Liturgy. 7. Study of the Sacramental theology in general, as well as of the theology of individual sacraments. 8. Study of the occurrence and development of individual liturgical acolouthia and rites. 9. Theoretical and practical introduction to the liturgical order of individual acolouthia and rites.		
Practical classes (exercises, additional forms of classes, research work)	The same themes in applicative aspect (with the stress on the qualified analysis of relevant sources, synchronous, diachronic and confrontational observation and generalization of liturgical phenomena and elements, as well as on the skills of active and productive usage of literature on liturgics, teleturgics and liturgic theology). Introduction to various kinds and elements of Christian worship by active participation in liturgical acolouthia and celebration of divine offices. Independent performance of certain liturgical units. Because of the specific nature of the Faculty in its system of teaching, special forms of lectures, pastoral-catechetical and practical-liturgical practice are organized according to its Statute.
