Course objectives	Review of basic philosophical questions and problems in the perspective of development of Russian philosophy in historical context is to provide insight into the basic developmental structures of philosophy and the analysis of the key traditions and movements in philosophy within epochs of renaissance and modern history respectively, especially in the context of main similarities and differences of philosophical traditions in the West and in the East. Introduction to Russian religious-theological context of original issues of philosophy, as well as reflections on contemporary forms of the dispute between humanistic and Christian philosophy.
