Prophet writers; Content of prophets' words; Narrative forms in prophets' words. 4. The prophets of Ancient Israel. Prophets in the early Israelite period; The prophets from Samuel to the division of the Kingdom (1040-922). 5. Prophets non writers: Elijah and Elisha. 6. Major prophets. 7. Minor prophets.
