Course objectives	Acquiring of theoretical knowledge of the main streams of life of the Patriarchate of Pec during the Middle Ages. Mastering the skill of analysis of source documents related to the aforementioned period.

Course content					
	The period from the proclamation of the Patriarchate in 1346 until the fall of Despotate in 1459 will be dealt with in one semestral course. Out of ten Patriarchs during that period Jefrem was the one who was twice on the throne of Pec. Patriarch Sava IV spent the longest period on the throne, and Patriarch Arsenije - the shortest. There were two patriarchs during the period of Empire; the rest of them ruled in the periods when Serbia was Principality or Despotate. Out of ten patriarchs the six of them were on the throne while Stefan Lazarević was prince and despot. The widest rule, in territorial sense, had Joanikije, and Arsenije - the narrowest. All patriarchs came to the throne after the death of their predecessor. Only once was the throne left empty by resignation. During this period Serbia had six rulers - two Emperors, one prince and three despots. In the beginning, when Patriarchate was proclaimed, state borders of Serbia had reached Thessaloniki, while in the period before the fall of Despotate the state
